FIRST 15 GRADS COMPLETE CHW PROGRAM

SCC's **Community Health Worker** program's first cohort of 15 students graduated and are ready to bridge community and healthcare in Sacramento!

The pathway program is a partnership between SCC, Greater Sacramento Urban League, Health Net, and WellSpace Health. It prepares students to provide support to local residents who are navigating the often complex and overwhelming healthcare system. Graduates may pursue careers as Patient/Health Navigators, Community Health Educators or Enrollment Specialists.

According to the Bureau of Labor Statistics (BLS), the demand of these types of workers in continuing to grow, BLS estimates a growth rate of 21% by 2020 thus increase the demand for qualified workers in Sacramento and across the country.
