Dear Student Senate,

The Business Society at Sacramento City College is a student led organization that strives to provide personal and professional growth opportunities to students both within the business division and throughout the college. To that end we offer a variety of programs including:

Guest Speakers - We schedule at least three speakers each semester who add value to our students through career education, industry insights, business culture exposure, and job skill development. Two of the speakers scheduled for this semester are:

- Sutter COO Speaks: Exploring Careers in Health Industry: All Majors Needed!
- Dr. Charles Ware, Campus Director, National Career Education; Mental and Physical Health: The Importance of Resilience to Overcome Life's Challenges

Field Trips - These trips are designed to educate students off campus about business career opportunities and business operations practices. Our scheduled trips for this semester UC Davis Business Career Placement Center and Google. We expect approximately 30 - 40 students to attend each event.

Skill Development Activities/workshops - We use workshops and activities to help students develop and practice necessary soft skills critical to career success that are not immediately available through normal coursework. Examples include elevator speech development, networking skills practice, teamwork opportunities, and marketing/fundraising activities. Members have already expressed positive feedback in how these activities will help them further their professional careers after college.

Our Fall 2017 Semester calendar is attached and includes scheduled events. Our goal is to duplicate this plan for Spring 2018 semester with new speakers, field trips, and activities.


We are a club on the move to grow our membership through the aforementioned activities and much more. We have produced videos for instructors to market the club, flyers to advertise meetings and market our presence on campus, and we have a sharp website with easy sign up for new members. Our goal is to have 200 members on our mailing list by the end of this academic year, and have 30-40 members for each field trip, up 25 percent from last year by offering and promoting exceptional opportunities for SCC students.

We are in need of ongoing funds to sponsor our events. To that end, we are hosting fundraisers, soliciting support from nearby businesses, and requesting money from campus sources including the Student Empowerment Grant. The \$400 grant will be used to pay advertising banners, T-shirts, and supplies to support our recently changed name. Our specific expenditures include the following:
