- 1 Student service (STS)** Available services include Admissions and Records, Financial Aid, and Disability Services. We also have an International Students Office on the main floor, while upstairs houses photography classrooms and a photo gallery.
- 2 Rodda Hall-North (RHN)** houses a variety of student support resources, including Business Services, General Counseling, the Transfer Center, Panthers Den, EOPS, the Undocu Resource Center, and Re-Emerging Scholars.

- 3 **Joan Didion Learning Resource Center (LRC)** offers essential academic support services, including free tutoring, printing stations, and on-site IT help—making it a key resource for student success.
- 4 **South Gymnasium (SOG)** Visit the Cultural Engagement Center on the first floor, home to ASHE, the Native American Program, the RAZA Center, and the Athletics Office. On the second floor, you'll find the API Center, Pride Center, CalWORKs, and Student Leadership & Development—each offering support, resources, and community for our diverse student population.
- 5 **City Café (CIC)** Our newly renovated café that offers a variety of affordable, student-friendly options including burgers, pizza, paninis, a fresh salad bar, pancakes, and more—perfect for a quick bite between classes or a casual lunch with friends.
